

Sunday Service: The Yokes of the Enemy

10th August 2014

The Word:

- Whatever spirit we carry, we begin to have the effect of that spirit in our lives
- The effect of God is the power to produce. We cannot come to God without being affected
- There are yokes the enemy puts over us, one of these is fear
- We are not slaves again to fear, when we come into relationship with God, His effect over our lives means that fear is broken
- A yoke represents oppression, slavery, bondage and we can often be unaware that we are yoked
- Yokes are placed on us by the power of words and thoughts. The enemy's strategy is to make his thoughts become our words
- These are not the words of the Lord, as Christians we should have peace
- Jesus came to set us free, it is the anointing that breaks the yokes
- Put into action the word of God, recognise your position, we have *all* authority over the enemy
- Authority is the power given to a believer, it is for binding the works of the enemy. Don't beg God for it, *thank* Him for it
- Every time we declare the name of Jesus, the atmosphere changes
- We need to come against the atmosphere the enemy wants to bring around our lives with name of Jesus
- Sometimes we live the way we do because of the things we've allowed the enemy to bring around our lives
- We have a spiritual inheritance. We didn't receive the spirit of the world, but the spirit of sonship.
- We are adopted into the family of God. We need to exercise our rights

Key Scriptures:

- Rom 8 v12-15: "For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear... you have received a spirit of sonship."
- 2 Tim 1v7: "For God has not given us a spirit of fear..."
- Mat 18v18: "Whatever you shall bind on earth, shall be bound in heaven..."
- Isa 54v17: "no weapon formed against you shall prosper... This is the heritage of the servants of The Lord..."
