

Sunday Service: The Love of God

12th October 2014

The Word:

- The enemy tries to weaken and pervert God's love, this is because God's love is His power, the power that sets us free
- Every time we come to Him there should be change – how can we not be transformed in His glory?
- We are called to be participants in what God is doing, not observers
- Revelation is the word of God alive within us, it allows us to take legal claim of what He has promised us
- We can often let the love shown to us by our natural father taint God's love, we must remember God's love is perfect and unconditional
- We are called to not simply know in our *minds* but in our *spirit* – this is revelation
- Nothing can separate us from His love
- Let His great love flow out of us and out to others – how can we keep it to ourselves?
- Everything in God has an effect; the effect of God's love is that we first love Him and then we love others
- We are called to not just have what we can see but also what He can see
- The love of God will compel us – Jesus didn't just have compassion but was actually moved with compassion
- We do not serve a God of 'just enough' or 'just scraping through' but a God of overwhelming and abounding abundance

- Ephesians 4v18: "...due to the hardening of their hearts."
- 2 Peter 1v5-7
- Jeremiah 31v3 "...I have loved you with an everlasting love."
- Psalm 103v8-18: "The Lord is...slow to anger, abounding in love."
- 2 Corinthians 1v20
- Ephesians 3v19-20: "... and to know this love that surpasses knowledge"
- Romans 8v37-39: "...we are more than conquerors through him who loved us."
