The Word:

- We should always be seeking an encounter with God
- We can't live on someone else's encounter
- We should experience God's presence tangibly, it is something we feel
- To Manifest is to *reveal in person*
- Many times we don't discern God's presence
- We can never discern what is counterfeit if we've never experienced the real love of God
- We should never stay as we are, Jesus came to take our burdens
- God has called our church to be free of depression
- Jesus is the prince of peace, there is no reason for us to live without peace
- Every time we encounter The Lord we are being transformed and changed
- The unsundered mind cannot walk in the ways of God
- When you come into the presence of God, you begin to think like Him
- When the 12 spies were sent out, Caleb and Joshua had the mind of God, the other 10 spies didn't
- Every time we fail to operate in true repentance, our hearts becomes hardened towards God
- Genuine repentance brings genuine change
