The Word:

- When Christians don't change, we end up in stagnation
- Not changing means we are conforming to or coming into agreement with the world
- We don't just fall into negative mind sets, it's a process of us agreeing with negative thoughts over time
- The enemy places thoughts in our minds directly by speaking straight to us, or indirectly by speaking through others
- There are two prominent spirits operating in this world- the spirit of Jezebel and the spirit of antichrist
- Both of these spirits attack God's original intention for the family unit
- Man was established by God as the head of the home. Homes are meant to work in unity
- Divorce is never the intention of God. It doesn't happen in a moment, it's a process
- We all have deficiencies which we are required to change, we must die to self
- Transformation is the process by which God brings us to maturity
- Our body and our mind follow the movement and revelation of the spirit
- When the mind is not renewed, we will repeat the cycles of life
- We need to reject the words that aren't from God before they take root, or they will form strongholds
- Every day there's an opportunity to either accept or reject the words that come to our spirit
- When we surrender to the things of God, He begins the process of renewing our minds
