The Word:

- Today in society we are seeing gender confusion, the removal of Fathers from the home, homosexuality, and alternative lifestyles
- God's heart is to see healthy families, loving Fathers, no divorce
- The role and function of the man is important. Men display the masculinity and strength of God, they represent Him on earth
- When fathers are in the home, there is security and strength there
- In media we see the adoption of the spirit of this age
- In the church we see the pressure to conform to society, and the adoption of philosophies that were never of God
- There is a process to everything- divorce, unforgiveness, depression, anxiety, etc.
- The life we are living has been formed out of the decisions we have made over time
- The carnal mind is in opposition to God. When the enemy wants to take a person captive, he attacks them in the mind
- God wants to give us His mind, His thoughts, His power. He tells us to take every thought captive
- What lives in the heart is revealed in actions. Our actions don't lie
