The Word:

- We should be living a supernatural experience
- We have all the supernatural capacity that God has provided us through the Word
- We become discouraged as we look at others naturally, we need to look at the world through the eyes of God
- When we come to Jesus, we should not continue to identify with our old life, it stops us from being what God wants us to be
- We must identify and align ourselves with God & His word
- As long as we don't let go of our past, we can't lay hold of our future
- There should be ongoing radical change in our lives
- God exalts a humble heart, we should be willing to pay the price without being acknowledged
- The natural man doesn't receive revelation. We need to be more hungry for the things of the Spirit than the things of the world
- Keep your eyes open in the spirit for the opportunities that God brings
- Be seeking Gods wisdom and revelation on the mountain top and in the valley
- God told Abraham to separate from his old life and he did. Often what God asks of us contradicts our own desires
- When we operate in a leadership role in the church, we need to realise it's a supernatural role, it's not about our natural ability
- God is bringing His family together from every nation on earth, we need to embrace all, we are not building a natural family
- The supernatural blessing of God comes around those who follow God
